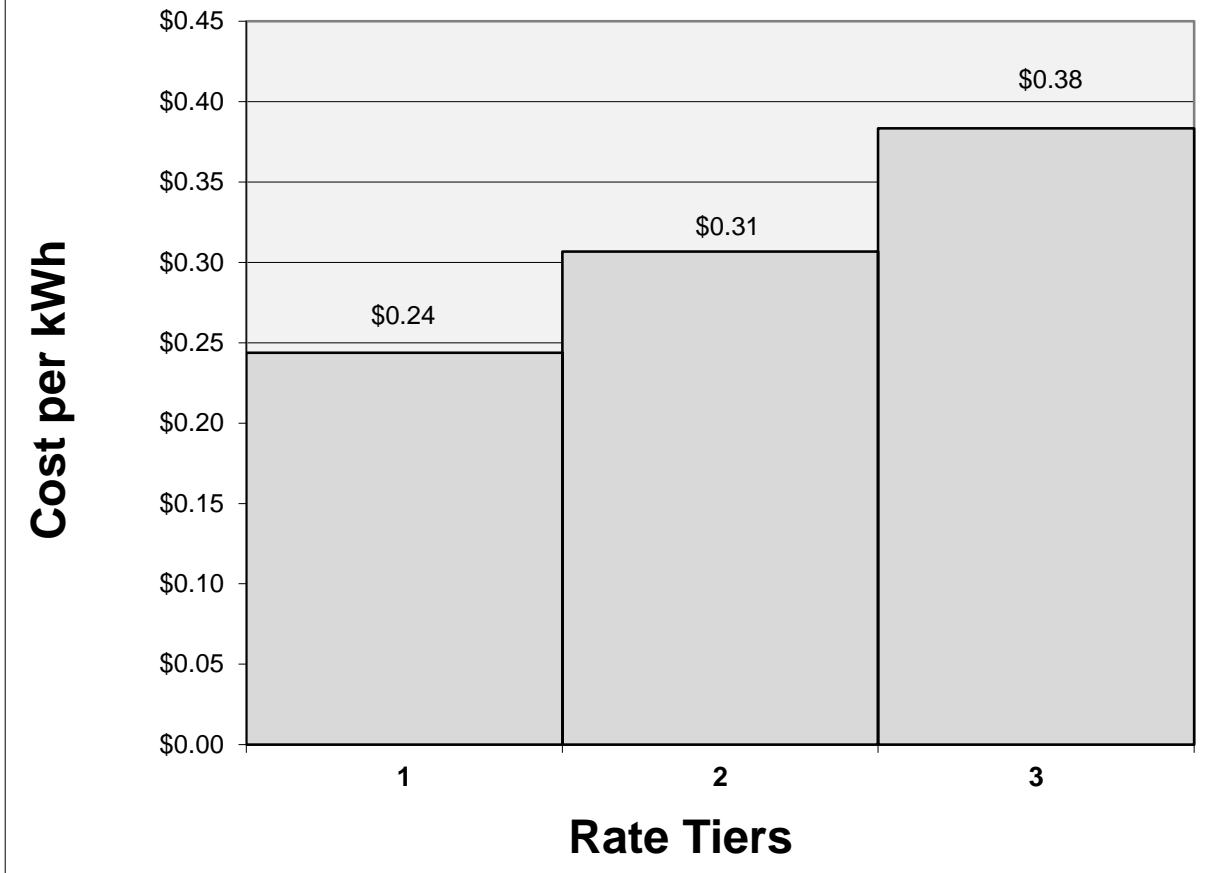


## PG&E Residential Electric Rates E1 Schedule as of Oct. 1, 2020



### Monthly Electric Bill

Summer baseline basic electric (10.1 kWh/day, Territory X):

Tier 1: Baseline	up to \$75	0 - 306 kWh
Tier 2: 101 - 400% of Baseline	\$76 - \$357	307 - 1,224 kWh
Tier 3: Over 400% of Baseline	over \$358	1,225+ kWh

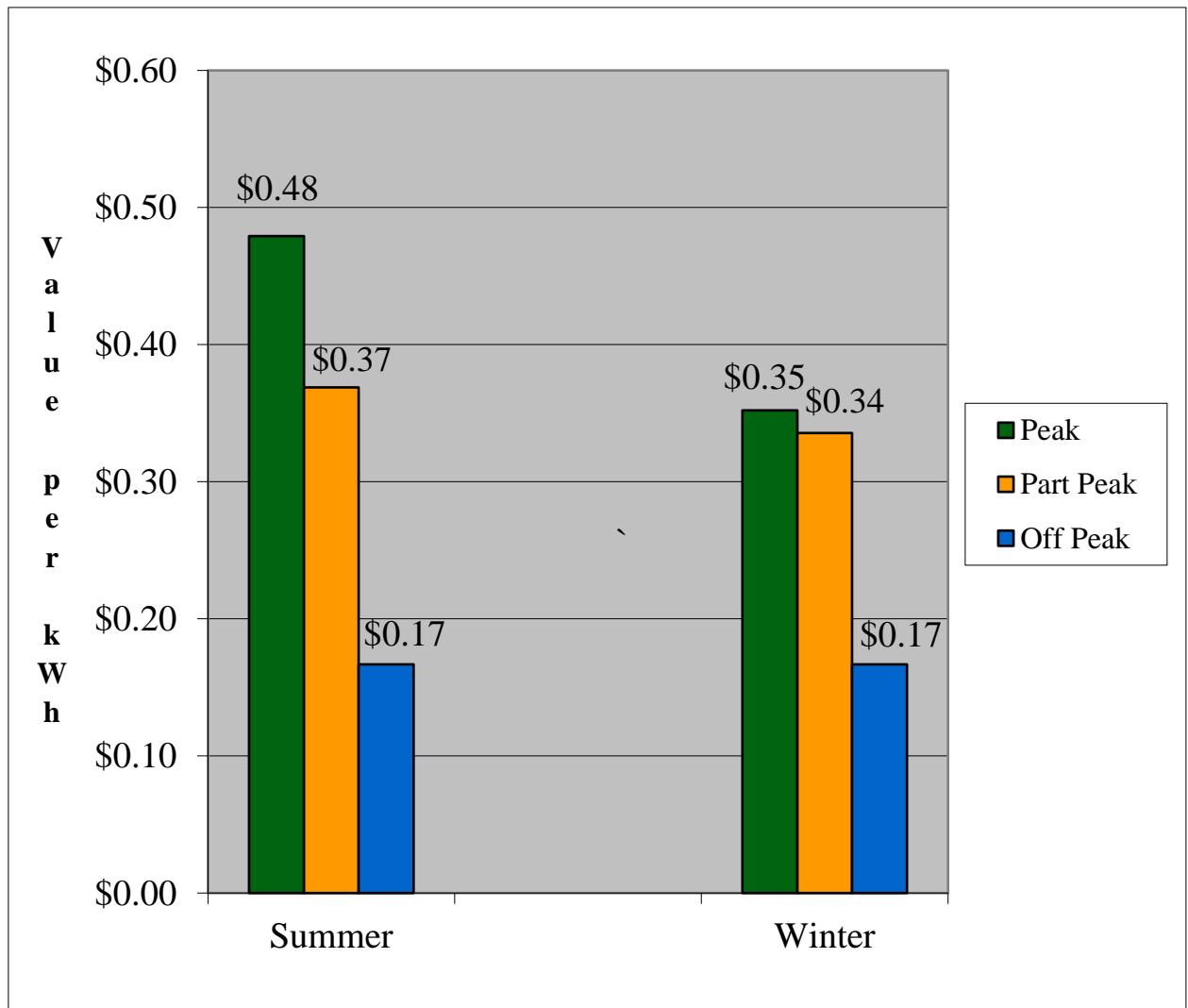
Winter baseline basic electric (10.9 kWh/day, Territory X):

Tier 1: Baseline	up to \$80	0 - 330 kWh
Tier 2: 101 - 400% of Baseline	\$81 - \$384	331 - 1,320 kWh
Tier 3: Over 400% + of Baseline	over \$385	1,321+ kWh

Summer period is May 1 - Oct. 31

Winter period is Nov. 1 - Apr. 30

Peak Hours: 4 pm - 9 pm All Days

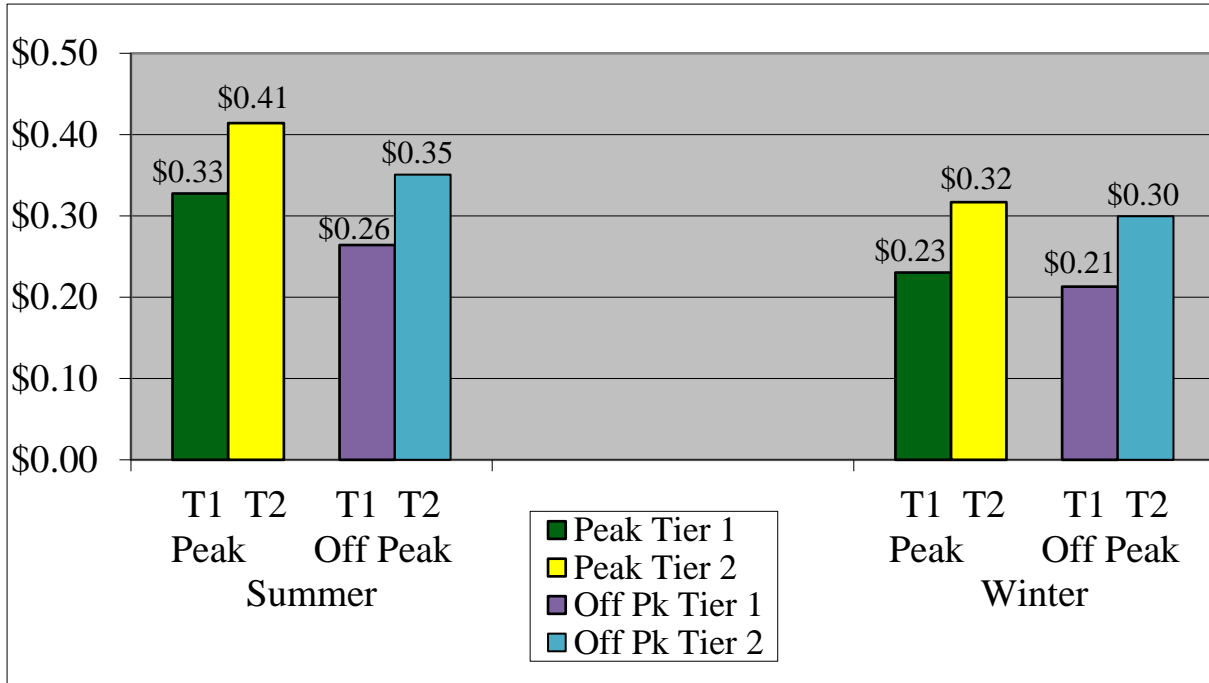
Partial-Peak Hours: 3 pm - 4 pm & 9 pm - 12 am All Days

**PG&E ETOU (option C) Time-of-use Residential Rate Schedule, as of 10/1/20**



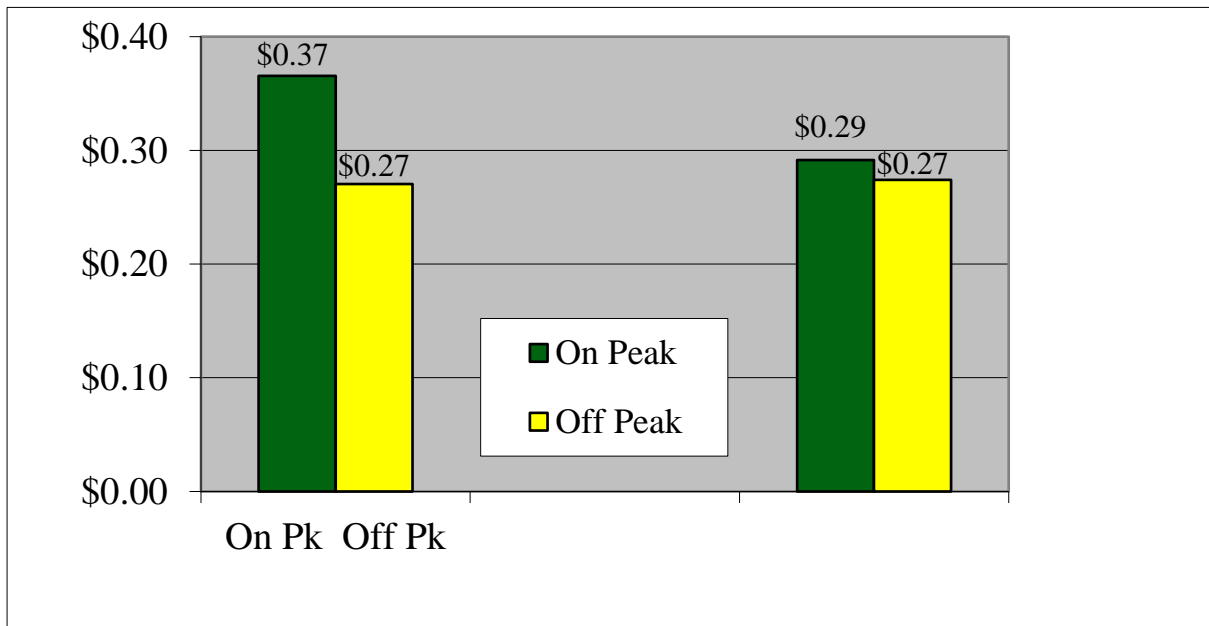
ETOU-C On-Peak Times

5 pm - 8 pm, Monday - Friday

ETOU-D Off-Peak Times

All other times (includes holidays)

Summer period: June 1 - Sept. 30

Winter period: Oct. 1 - May 31

Holidays: New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
